### **ANDREW'S PICKS**

### The Duel. (Chang Cheh, 1971)

In the late 1960s in Hong Kong, two new directors began making wuxia and kung fu films for Shaw Brothers Studio: King Hu and Chang Cheh. They are two of the greatest action directors—indeed, two of the greatest filmmakers - who ever lived, though their styles could hardly be more different. It is fascinating to compare Hu's first film as director, Come Drink with Me(1966), with its sequel Golden Swallow (1968), which was the second film directed by Chang: both films are martial arts dramas

starring the legendary actress Cheng Pei-pei, but their styles are diametrically opposed. Hu's films are among he most beautiful ever made: you remember the golden sunlight in a bamboo forest or the sound of water falling over stone as much as you remember the mind-blowing action scenes, which even at their most violent are always conducted with balletic grace. There is a serenity to Hu's films, a spiritual transcendence, and an artistic perfection that is altogether lacking in the prolific Chang's far more wild and varied body of work. Yet many of Chang's films are masterpieces of a very different kind: they are fast-paced and jagged, angular and staccato, often shocking and always supremely entertaining. This is certainly the case with The Duel, an ultra-violent revenge thriller starring David Chiang and Ti Lung. If you like action movies, check it out!

### Makerspace: Lego Block Party! July 3rd at 3:00pm


